Reporting directly to the Chief of Staff, Chief Operating Officer, and Governor Lamont I lead large interagency teams to craft and implement key priority policies for the Lamont Administration. My role requires the coordination and management of dozens of employees within the Governor's Office and across Connecticut state agencies to successfully implement projects, external partnerships, and policies with budgets combining in the hundreds of millions of dollars.

Design, Lead, and Manage Large Teams to Execute Priority Policies and Initiatives for Governor Lamont:

- I designed and led inter-agency team from the Governor's office to overhaul the state's workforce development system. Vastly improving Connecticut's workforce development system has been one of Governor Lamont's top priorities in his first term. The work included:
 - o Building, funding and staffing new state workforce office, designed to lead and coordinate Connecticut's entire workforce infrastructure.
 - Creation of new Connecticut state workforce board requiring the recruiting and appointing of top business, education, and workforce training officials.
 - Leading large group of state agencies, top employers, educators, and non-profits to formulate and execute a 12-month improvement plan for Connecticut's workforce pipeline.
 - Led the CT Back to Work initiative, a partnership with Indeed and workforce training companies to provide workforce training and job-placement services to tens of thousands of Connecticut residents during COVID-19 pandemic.
- Serve as lead from Governor's Office for reopening K-12 schools during the COVID-19 pandemic including leading large cross-agency teams, coordinating with the State Department of Education, State Department of Public Health and other state agencies on all aspects of reopening K-12 schools and remote learning since outset of Covid-19 in March, 2020. Including:
 - o Designing of state guidelines, policies and budgets for school reopening.
 - Creation of one of nation's first weekly data trackers of districts offering fully in-person, hybrid, or remote learning models and tracking of positive infection cases reported among K-12 students and staff.
 - Standardizing K-12 reopening metrics and goals, and leading weekly cross-agency call with Chief Operating Officer and commissioners of Education and Public Health, to track progress on goals and discuss next step interventions.
 - Led Governor's Office briefings for Governor Lamont on weekly reopening progress and discussion of key policy decisions and next steps
 - o Creation of a nation-leading data system to track monthly student attendance across all populations.
 - o Crafting and deployment of over \$250M of CARES Act money to support school reopening
- Crafted and led *The Everybody Learns Initiative*, a \$64M state program to close the digital divide during COVID-19 pandemic. Led a team of more than ten across five agencies to coordinate logistics and funding for deploying 141,00 laptops, and 41,000 at-home internet connections to students across 220 school districts, and 160 free public WiFi hotspots across the state. Led team process to negotiate contracts with seven different internet service providers/
 - The Everybody Learns Initiative resulted in Connecticut being the first state in the nation to close its K-12 digital divide by providing a laptop and internet connection to every student who indicated a need.

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- Led design and financing proposal for public private partnership of \$200M Data Science Center in Stamford, Connecticut and serve as Governor's representative on Stamford project design board.
- Led an inter-agency team to launch state public private partnership with AT&T to build the first 5G network on a commuter rail in America.
- Led Governor's Office team to recruit, and onboard hundreds of contact tracers during Covid-19, ultimately resulting in an operation of 1,000+ contact tracers.
- Led the launch of and serve as Chair of the State's 5G Council, an eight-member Council that directs agencies and municipalities on state 5G policy and guidelines.
- Developed plan and led inner-agency effort to design \$11M community engagement program to fund large group of social workers in needlest districts to engage with families of chronically absent students to support their return to school and bridge to summer programming.

Oversee financial diligence processes, crafting of budgetary proposals, and implementation of funds combining to hundreds of millions of dollars.

Lead overall K-12, higher education, workforce and broadband policy formation for Governor Lamont within Governor's Office and help oversee policy formation across agencies.

Lead the writing and introduction of Governor's legislation on bills relating to K-12 education, higher education and broadband and manage the legislative process.

 In the 2021 Legisative session, I led a multi-agency policy process to write and introduce one of Governor Lamont's top priority Governor's bills – a largescale effort to drastically improve access to high-speed broadband across Connecticut and to create a new state office for broadband policy and operations.

Serve as a lead ambassador from the Governor's Office for K-12 education, higher education, workforce development and broadband to external parties such as the media, state legislators, municipalities, school districts, state teachers, superintendents, colleges and universities, internet service providers, advocate groups and non-profit organizations.
