  - Designed and executed a K-12 public health system that supported school reopening in September, including same-day test appointments with same-day results and dedicated contact tracing with customer service for schools and districts
  - Launched monoclonal antibody treatment program to prevent COVID hospitalizations, increasing treatments given per week in Rhode Island 10x between end of November and mid-January
  - O Launched Rhode Island's vaccine program, ranked 15<sup>th</sup> in the country for 1<sup>st</sup> dose administration per capita and 7<sup>th</sup> in 2<sup>nd</sup> dose administration per capita as of 1/20/21
